#### ☒ Basic Self-Introductions:

#### ☒ Sharing Personal Details:

- "I am a student/teacher/engineer."
- "I like to read, cook, and travel."
- "I speak English and Spanish."

◇ **Example Dialogue:** A: "Hello! My name is Sarah. What's your name?"

B: "Hi, my name is John. Nice to meet you!"

A: "Nice to meet you too! Where are you from?"

B: "I'm from Mexico. And you?"

A: "I'm from Canada."
