Pronouns

Page 1 – Subject and Object Pronouns

Remember: A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a noun.

Three important kinds of pronouns are:

- **Subject pronouns:** I, you, he, she, it, we, they
- **Object pronouns:** me, you, him, her, it, us, them
- **Possessive pronouns:** mine, yours, his, hers, ours, theirs
